THE COMMEMORATIVE TREE PROGRAM is sponsored by the Cape Girardeau Parks & Recreation Foundation and the City of Cape Girardeau Parks and Recreation Department. This program helps commemorate a special person or occasion while simultaneously helps beautify the community.

Memorial stones are approximately 8 x 12 inches, and will be placed in the ground at the foot of the commemorative tree. Each stone will list the person, group or occasion that is being honored.

HOW IT WORKS

A commemorative tree can be given in memory or in honor of special people, groups, or occasions. Trees are planted in various parks managed by the Cape Girardeau Parks and Recreation Department.

1 ENROLL

To arrange for the planting of a commemorative tree, simply fill out the enrollment form in this brochure, return it to the Cape Girardeau Parks and Recreation Department, indicate the name of the person or group or occasion to be commemorated by your gift and the type of tree you wish planted.

2 SELECT A PARK

You may [request a specific park](#) where your commemorative tree is to be planted. The Cape Girardeau Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to approve tree selections and site locations.

3 PAYMENT

A program fee of \$350.00 will be used to purchase and plant a specified tree with an appropriately inscribed memorial stone.

Please make your check payable to the Cape Girardeau Parks & Recreation Foundation Commemorative Tree Program.

4 WE'LL NOTIFY YOU

Trees will be planted from October 1st through the end of April. You will be notified once the tree is planted, the stone is set and everything is complete.
