Capaha Park Ballfield/Stadium Complex Improvements

Capaha Park Baseball Stadium has served as the home of the Capaha Baseball Team since the late 1800's, along with being host to our local American Legion teams and the Southeast Missouri State Redhawks baseball team. The ballfield's natural turf was recently replaced with artificial turf; greatly improving the field playability. The aging scoreboard was also replaced with a new digital display and updated graphics. The remaining improvements needed include replacing the ballfield sports lighting, replacing the old restroom with an updated restroom/concession pavilion, renovating the grandstand seating, and improving accessibility.

Lighting

Aging sports lighting needs to be replaced with more energy efficient LED lighting.

Restrooms/Concessions

Lack of quality and quantity of restroom/concession facilities to manage large events.

Facility Gating

Lack of ability to "gate" and charge entry to facility to offset expenses.

Accessibility

Lack of accessibility and quality spectator seating to manage large events.

Hillside Seating

Improvehillsideseating and accessibility.

PROJECT SCOPE

- Partnership with Southeast Missouri State University.
- Replace sports lighting with energy efficient LED system.
- Replace restroom and construct new concession/storage areas for the ballfield.
- Add perimeter fencing/gating system to control entry and access.
- Renovate spectator seating to provide improved accessibility and fan experience, as funding allows.
- Add homerun deck behind right field to enhance VIP area and fan experience, as funding allows.
- Add locker room and coach's offices as funding allows.


PROJECT OUTCOMES
