

Portable toilets degrade the aesthetic appearance of a city park/ facility often with an accompanying odor and are often vandalized.

PROJECT SCOPE

- Build a minimum of five (5) permanent restroom facilities in planned locations throughout the park system.
- Examples would be Arena Park Trail Head, South parking lot near the Red House, Dennis Scivally Park, Indian Park, Osage Trail Head, and the Shawnee Park Trail Head.

PROJECT OUTCOMES

- ★ Decrease rental cost of portable toilets.
- ★ Improve aesthetics of the parks.
- ★ Improve access and usability.
