Free AutoPay

Have your utility bill automatically deducted from your bank account on the due date. Register using the back of your bill or at cityofcape.org/autopay

Use Bank Bill Pay

Use your banking institution's online bill pay to pay your utility bill. You must enter and/or reference your account AND customer number listed on the top of your bill (includes a dash), for payment to be properly applied.
